The UC3 Dash (https://dash.ucop.edu) service provides an easy-to-use solution for the effective curation of and access to research data. Dash is a centralized UC3-hosted service, with UC and DataONE branded instances.

Recent Enhancements, News, and Activities

- We added a new instance of Dash in December: UC Santa Cruz Dash, https://dash.library.ucsc.edu/.
- We are currently working to bring up two more instances of Dash: UCSF Dash and Lawrence Berkeley Laboratory Dash.
