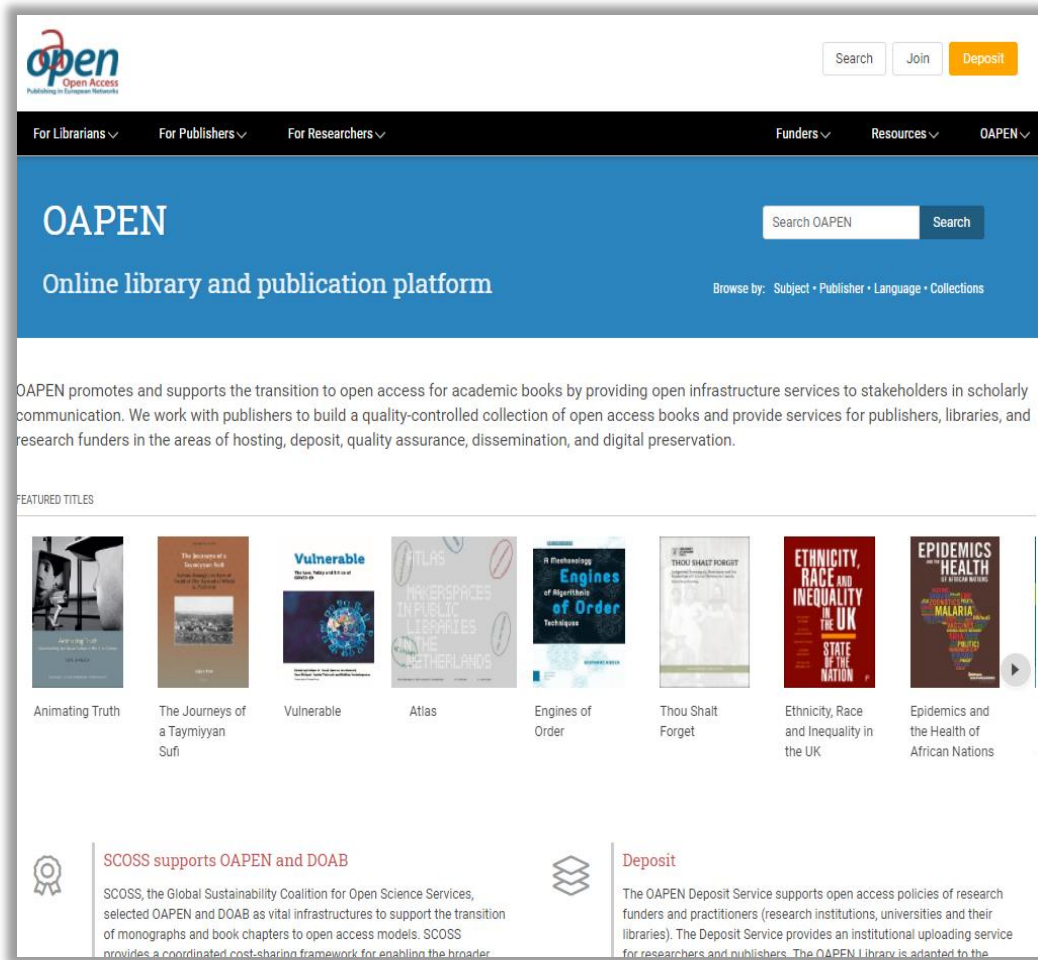

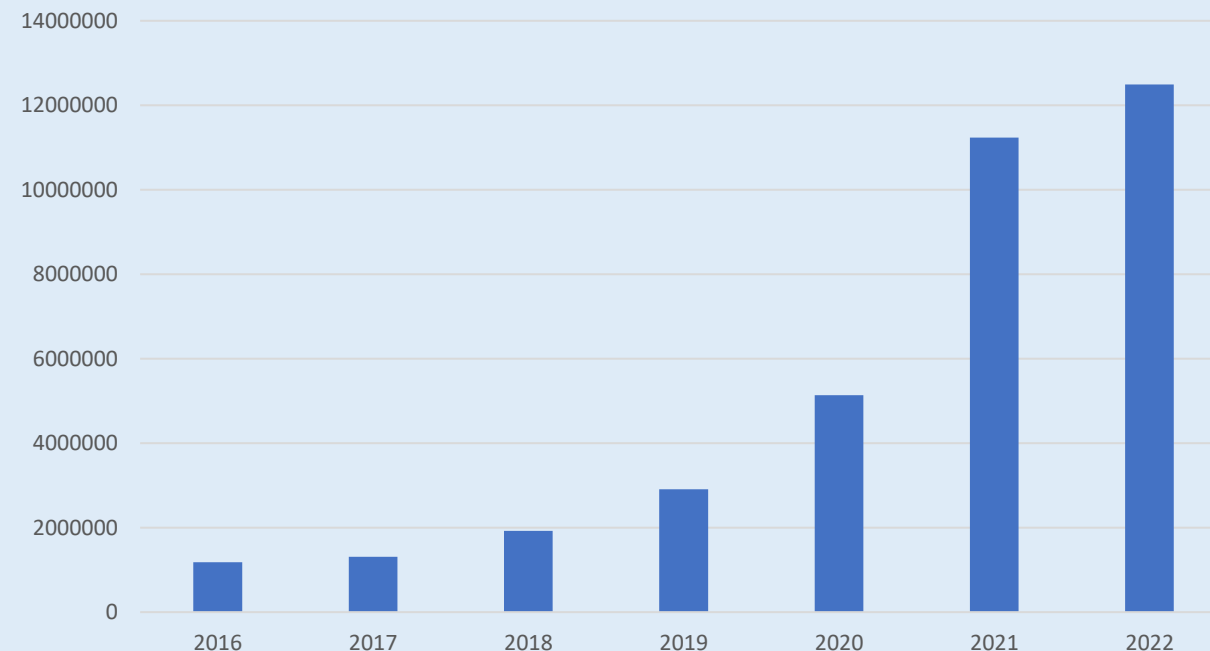

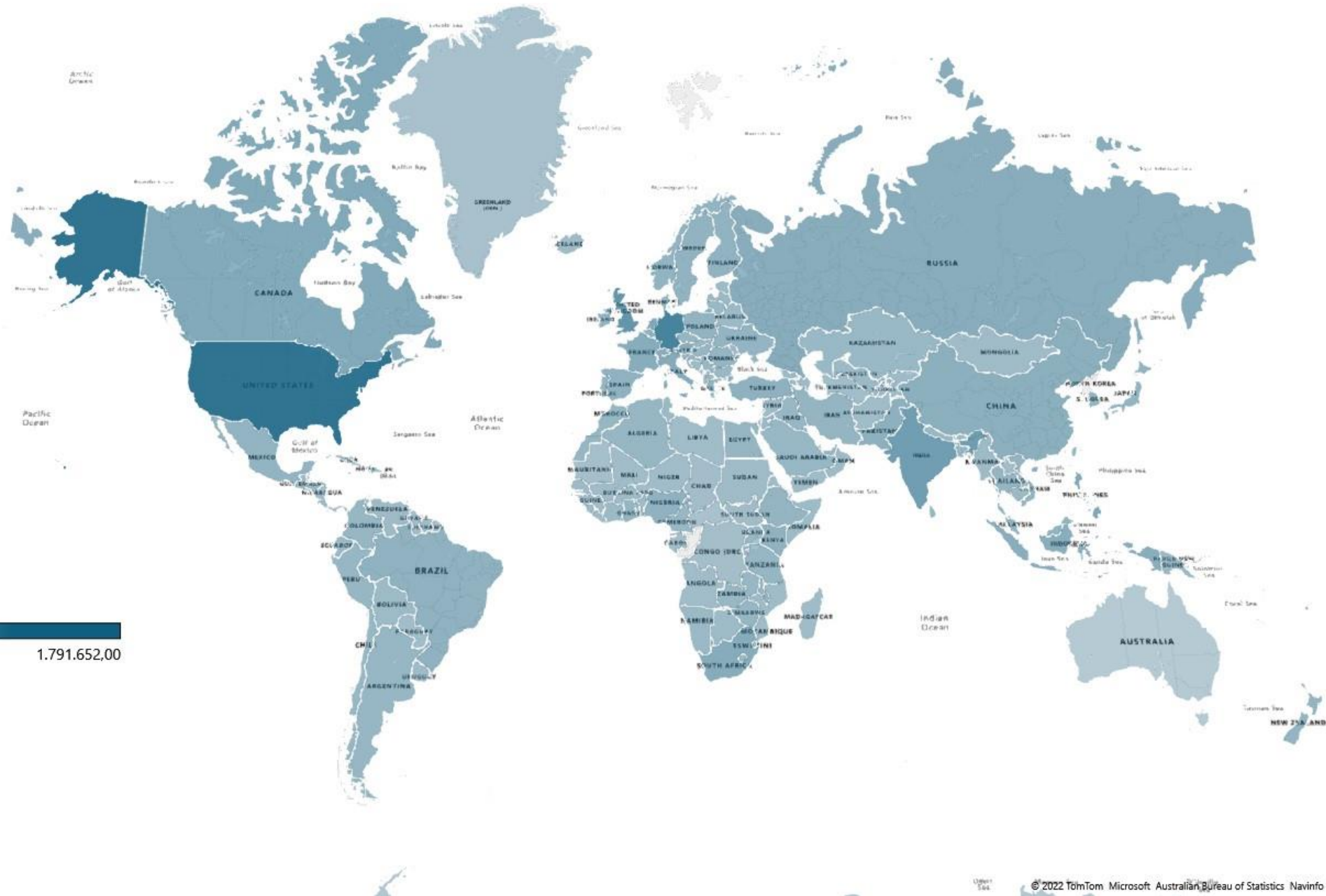

OAPEN downloads (Sum)



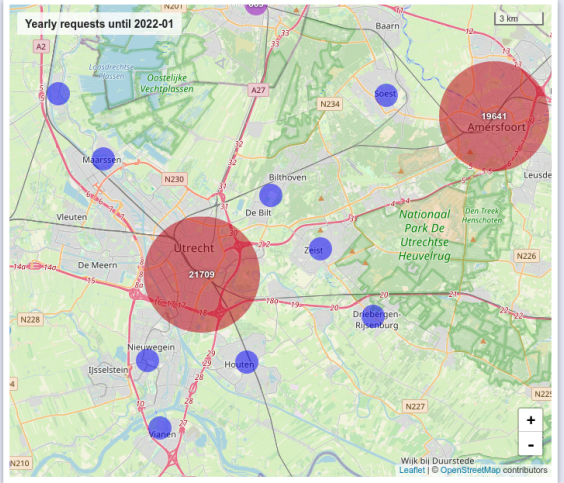
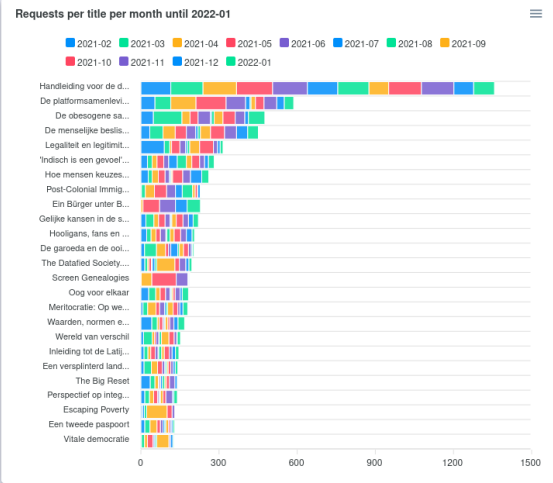

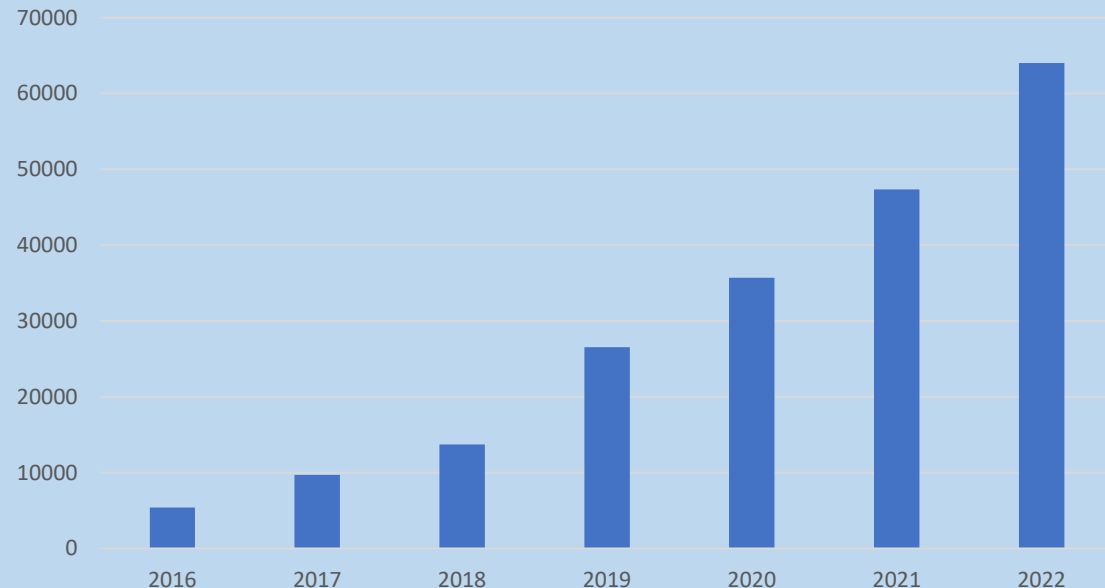

Peer Review Information Service for Monographs

PRISM provides academic publishers with the opportunity of displaying information about their peer review procedures across their entire catalogue, for individual book series, or even for single books.

The goal of the service is to provide transparency around the peer review procedures – opening the black box so to speak – and thereby build trust in academic book publishing.

The peer review information provided by the publisher will be visible to any reader and will also be added to the metadata of the books distributed by DOAB.

PRISM is currently operating in beta phase and will move into production in 2022.

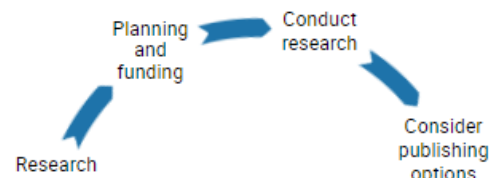

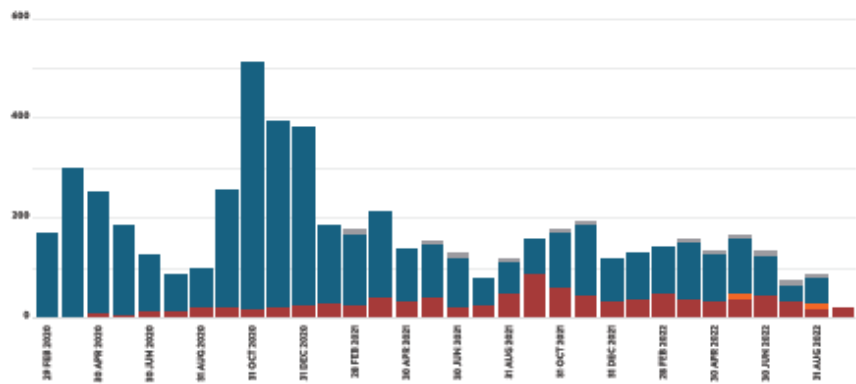

PALOMERA – Policy Alignment of Open access Monographs in the European Research Area

Objective: *To drive the transition towards more open access to academic books through policy development*

Project activities

- ❑ Data collection (qualitative and quantitative data) → creation of a knowledge base → OA books toolkit
- ❑ Analysis and actionable recommendations → OA books toolkit
- ❑ Inclusion of and engagement with stakeholders to qualify and validate project findings (data, analyses, recommendations) → OABN
